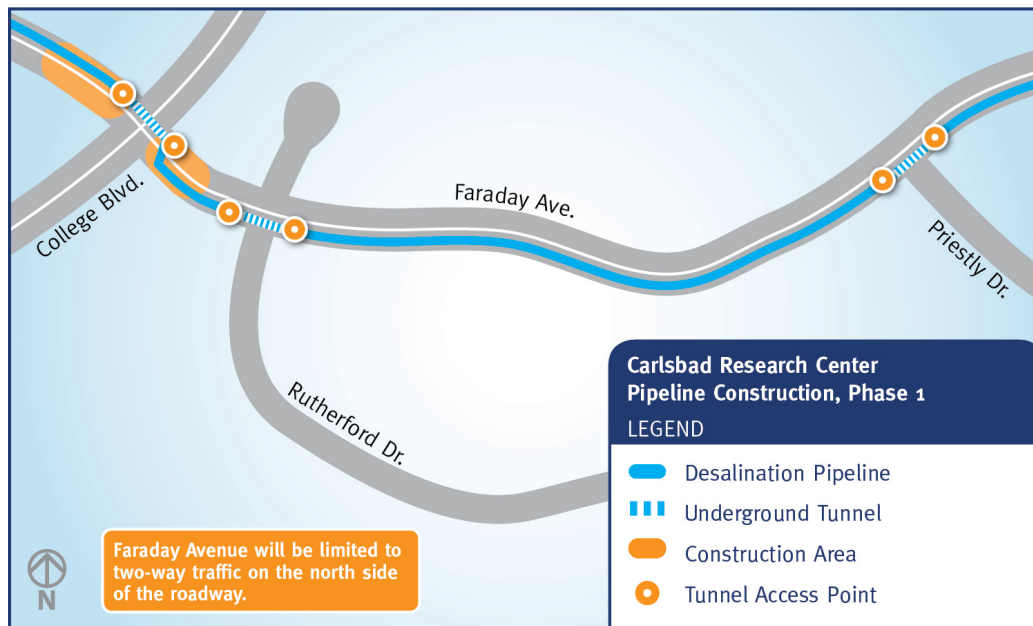

Carlsbad Construction Updates

This email is to keep you apprised of the Carlsbad Desalination Pipeline construction progress. We encourage you to share these emails with your employees and anyone who might be interested in work along the pipeline route within or adjacent to the Carlsbad Research Center.

Carlsbad Research Center Traffic Control

Construction work in the Carlsbad Research Center continues at the intersections of Van Allen Way and College Boulevard. During work, Faraday Avenue will continue to be limited to one lane of traffic in each direction. In mid-June traffic will be moved from the south side of Faraday to the north side of Faraday to ensure work area safety. During this time, limited driveways on the south side of Faraday will be closed. Access to businesses will be maintained at all times through alternative driveways. As work wraps up west of College Boulevard, restoration activities will follow the pipeline installation and will be completed prior to moving construction east of College Boulevard.



Additional Pipeline Construction Updates

As you plan your commute, we would like to keep you informed on other pipeline construction near the Carlsbad Research Center.

Cannon Road Now Open

Cannon Road, west of Grand Pacific Drive, is now open. To ensure safety, the existing traffic control on Cannon Road between Grand Pacific Drive and Faraday Avenue will be maintained through the year as the tunneling crew mobilizes to work on Marcario Canyon, the tunnel just west of the Cannon Road and Faraday Avenue intersection.

During construction, drivers should expect temporary lane closures, detours and reduced land widths, equipment along the route and should use caution and allow more time to reach their destination.
