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Construction on the Desalination Pipeline is scheduled to begin in your neighborhood this spring. The work will start at the San Diego County Water Authority's Second Aqueduct connection facility, located east of Rancho Santa Fe Road at Creek Street in San Marcos. Initially, the project will be constructed in phases from east to west.

The first phase of construction, which will stretch from Rancho Santa Fe Road to Poinsettia Avenue, is scheduled to be completed this fall. To offset the impacts of any road closures, detours have been planned to help maintain traffic flow and signage will be posted along construction areas. Thanks for your patience during construction of this vital water supply project.

About the Carlsbad Desalination Project

This historic project is the commencement of a 30-year water agreement between Poseidon Resources and the San Diego County Water Authority for the purchase of up to 50 million gallons per day of desalinated seawater. The water will be produced at the desalination plant located adjacent to the Encina Power Station in Carlsbad. It will be conveyed to the Water Authority's water delivery system via a 10-mile pipeline. Construction of the desalination plant began in December of 2012. The project is scheduled to be completed in 2016.
